NOTIFICATION REGARDING INTERNAL COMPLAINT COMMITTEE ELECTIONS

It is hereby notified that as per a communication received from the Proctor, University of Delhi, elections will be held to choose one class representative from the MA students for the sole and specific purpose of sending his/her name to the university for participation in the process of 2nd tier elections to choose 3 representatives for the Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) in terms of Section 4 (1) (C) of the University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employee and Students in higher education institutions) of the university.

Three representatives are required to be elected from MA (Semester II) of North Campus and a similar number from the South Campus. Each campus must be represented by at least one man and one woman out of a total of three students per campus. These six representatives will choose one representative out of themselves whose name will be sent to the university as a class representative to participate in the 2nd tier elections for ICC, to be held at the university level.

The eligibility criteria for contesting for the above are as under:

- 1. He/She should be a student pursuing regular degree course in the university.
- 2. Age limit for contesting the elections is 25 years.
- 3. Minimum 75% attendance in the previous year/semester.
- 4. No backlog of papers.
- 5. Must have secured at least 55% consolidated marks in the latest final examination.
- 6. Not subjected to any disciplinary action in the past and should not have any criminal records.

All regular students who wish to nominate themselves for being considered for the above purpose and who fulfil the eligibility conditions as stated above, may register on the Google form link given below latest by 5 PM of Wednesday, 15-06-2022. The concerned interested students should also upload copies of their current ID cards and copies of their marksheets of the last final examination (Graduation or equivalent). Students also need to upload a self-

declaration statement stating that they fulfil all the criteria for contesting elections. The elections of any person is subject to verification of documents/information at any stage. Only regular students are permitted to contest and/or vote.

No voting shall be allowed without prior registration. The registration as voters can also be done till 5 PM of Wednesday, 15-06-2022.
