

Rules for Decorating Selfie Point

- The selfie point should align with the theme "Crafting with Nature: Flora in Indian Handloom" and incorporate elements of "Viksit Bharat", reflecting the idea of a progressive and developed India.
- Participants must creatively showcase India's rich handloom heritage, traditional fabrics, and cultural motifs while incorporating floral elements in the design.
- Only students currently studying in UG/PG courses of Delhi University shall be eligible as participants for the event.
- Only one entry per College/Department/Institute/Hostel is allowed.
- A maximum of five participants per team is allowed.
- All the necessary materials required are to be arranged by respective teams only.
- Size of the frame to be used to create selfie point should not exceed 6 by 4 feet.
- Participants must predominantly use flowers (either fresh or paper/origami), Indian handloom fabrics (e.g., Khadi, Ikat, Banarasi, Chanderi, Kanjeevaram), or natural fibers (e.g., cotton, jute, silk, wool).
- Use of any **plastic material is strictly prohibited.**
- Selfie point can be decorated/assembled at the venue or even pre-decorated ones can be submitted as entries.
- Selfie points completed in all respects must be ready by 9:00 am on 28th February 2025.
- Each team must display their Institute's name prominently on the selfie stand.
- Judgement of the jury will be final.
- If the entries fail to meet the criteria of the proposed themes, the organizing committee reserves the right for not displaying any of the selfie points at the venue.
