It may be noted that the Adhoc Panel for the academic session 2023-24 shall remain valid till the

issuance of fresh Adhoc Panel for the academic session 2024-25. It may also be noted that all

those, desiring their names to be included in the Adhoc Panel for the academic session 2024-25,

are required to file fresh applications even if their names have figured in the earlier ad hoc panel.

Those who are interested and fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements as laid down by the

UGC/University of Delhi may submit their application forms online by following the below

mentioned link and filling the Google form latest by Monday, 8 July, 2024.

The candidates, who have been awarded a PhD Degree in Journalism (English) in accordance

with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for the award of

PhD Degree) Regulations 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of NET, subject to their

production of an appropriate certificate in this respect. Provided further that the award of degree

to candidates registered for PhD in Journalism (English) prior to 11th July 2009, shall be governed

by the provisions of then existing Ordinances/By-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such PhD in Journalism (English) holders shall be exempted from the requirement of NET, subject to an appropriate certificate indicating the following:

- a) That the Ph.D. Degree of the candidate was awarded in the regularmode.
- b) That the evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis was done by at least two external examiners.
- c) That an open Ph.D. viva voce examination of the candidate was conducted.
- d) That the candidate had published two research papers from/based on his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one was in a refereed journal.
- e) That the candidate had made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

It may be noted that the NET exemption certificate must be issued by either the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar or the Dean Academic/Academic Affairs, the Dean Examinations, the Controller of Examinations or an equivalent official of the concerned University. For candidates who have obtained their degree(s) from foreign Universities, equivalence certificate(s) from the Association of Indian Universities is mandatorily required for empanelment. Provided further that if the Ph.D. in Journalism (English) degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking at any time by any one of the following:

- (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS);
- (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE); or
- (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

The proof of ranking is also to be uploaded in the application.

It may be noted that the application form should be complete in all respects. Incomplete forms with inadequate documents will be summarily rejected. The Department reserves the right to reject the application even if the candidate has been a part of the previous ad-hoc panel. The responsibility of providing the relevant documents/certificates lies entirely with the candidates.

It may also be noted that late submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances.
